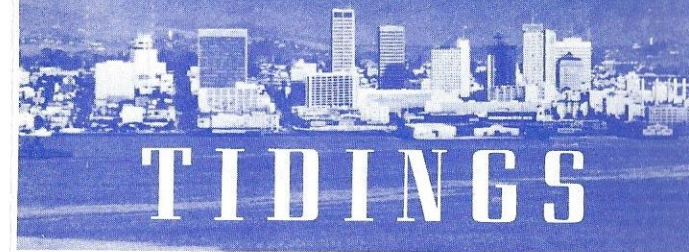

BARNEY MORRIS, Anchorman on KFMB-TV's late news (11:00 p.m.).

Mr. Morris is a graduate of Notre Dame University where he was an oratory and debate champion.

In the mid-sixties he worked at WXYZ-TV in Detroit as a newscaster and reporter. During the Detroit riots Morris was the acting news director for the station. The entire news department was nominated for a Pulitzer prize for its coverage of the riots.

He went on to become an anchorman for two Los Angeles TV stations - KTLA & KABC. While at these stations he was nominated for two Emmys for documentaries he produced.

Morris was hired by WCAU-TV in Philadelphia for the purpose of waging a ratings war. Even though he was earning a six figure salary, he was to be quoted later as saying, "I'd rather sell tacos in California than have to live in Philadelphia."
