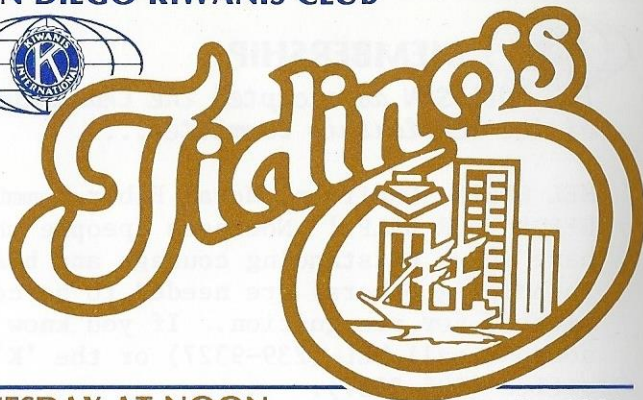

THE PROGRAM

J. CLIFFORD WALLACE, Circuit Judge, the United States Court of Appeals, Ninth Circuit, is a native San Diegan who has spent his entire legal career in the San Diego area. He is a graduate of San Diego State University (honors and distinction, 1952) and the School of Law, University of California, Berkeley.

Judge Wallace was admitted to the practice of law in 1955. He is a former partner in the law firm of Gray, Cary, Ames, and Fry. His accumulation of extra-curricular and other professional honors are much to numerous to mention in this limited space.

Among them are; President, Blue Key National Honor Fraternity; Who's Who in American Universities and Colleges; membership in the American, California, and San Diego Bar Associations.

Judge Wallace has authored many publications which have established him as an authority and one of demonstrated literary skills in the field of law. Most of the Who's Who listings in the West contain his name.

He became the U. S. District Judge, for California's Southern District in 1970. He was elevated to the U. S. Court of appeals in July 1972.

Most of us are sincerely interested in the status of law and justice in our society. This is an exceptional opportunity to hear an expert speak on this vital subject.

self and wife for the HOLDIDAY BOWL LUNCHEON next Tuesday...! YOU ARE NEEDED...!!!



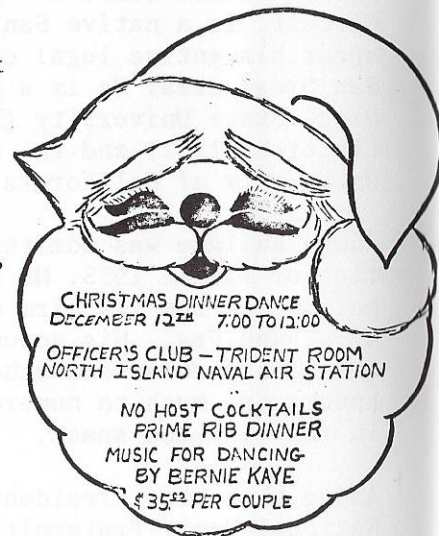


