BIRTHDAYS THIS WEEK

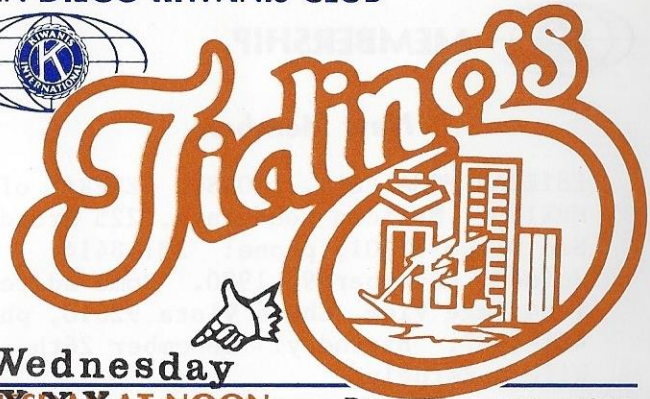

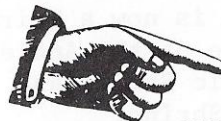
