Chip Carter has been a member of the California Highway patrol for almost twenty-five years serving in a variety of assignments in both field and staff operations. His field assignments include road patrol duties in the San Diego and Oakland areas.

In his staff assignments, Chief Carter has been involved in the CHP's departmental planning efforts and oversight of numerous programs including applicant investigations, recruitment and training. He also served as the Department's Legislative Liaison to the California Legislature and was Commander of the CHP Academy in Sacramento.

In July 2000 he was promoted to Asst. Chief and assigned as Assist Division Commander of Southern Division covering the entire Los Angeles County area. In December 2002, he was again promoted to Chief and accepted his current assignment as Chief of Border Division where he oversees the daily operations throughout the counties of San Diego, Orange, Imperial and most of Riverside with a staff of nearly 1400 sworn and non-sworn members.
