...FIRE CHIEF JEFF BOWMAN

Jeff Bowman was appointed Chief of the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department on May 6, 2002. Prior to his San Diego appointment, he held the position of Anaheim Fire Chief from December 9, 1986. His service career with the Anaheim Fire Department began in 1973 as a Fire-fighter, where he later was promoted through all ranks leading up to the top rung of Fire chief in 1986 after just 13 years—at 34 years of age, he was the youngest Fire Chief in America. Throughout his career, Chief Bowman has involved his fire department staff in a number of community activities, as well as making a personal commitment to the youth of his community by chairing fund raising events and participating on a variety of youth Boards.

Chief Bowman has served as President of the California Fire Chief's Association and has been singled out by Governors Wilson & Schwarzenegger for special assignments and was named "Fire Chief of the Year for 2004" by the Metropolitan Fire Chief's Association, which represents the world's 120 largest fire departments.

He and his wife, Denise, live in San Diego and have six grown children residing throughout the State of California.
