The Salk Institute opened its doors in 1965, just 10 years after its founder Jonas Salk, M.D., proved that his vaccine against polio was safe and effective. This November, the Salk Institute celebrates its 40th anniversary on its La Jolla campus, designed by the acclaimed architect Louis Kahn in collaboration with Salk.

Kathleen Murray came to the Salk Institute in 1988 following a career as publications director for Chicago Title and Trust. She earned a journalism degree from Mundelein College of Loyola University, authored a medical column for a women's magazine, and was a free-lance writer in Chicago and San Diego before joining the staff of the President's Office at Salk. Kathleen then became office administrator for Founding Director Dr. Jonas Salk until his death in 1995, then worked with Dr. Francis Crick developer of the helical structure of DNA. Currently she works with Nobel Laureates Renato Dulbecco and Sydney Brenner, as well as Dr. Leslie Orgel.

Kathleen's presentation is entitled "The Legacy of Jonas Salk."
