While Dr. Castruita was superintendent in Santa Ana, the district earned numerous awards and recognitions including Golden Bells, federal Blue Ribbon Schools and California Distinguished Schools. He has received the Marcus Foster Award from ACSA in 1991 and was named California's Superintendent of the Year in 1992.

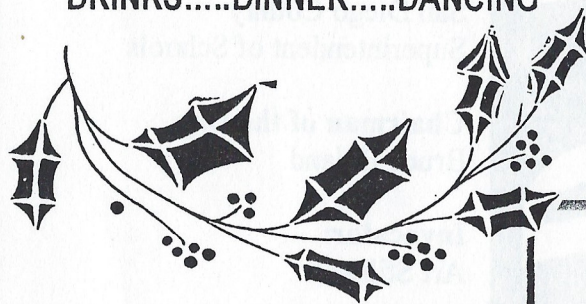
