Ed played his College football at University of California. He was All-American Defensive Tackle. He also graduated with a degree in landscape architecture.

Ed played for the NFL Vikings for seasons, going to 4 Super Bowls and 4 Pro-Bowls. He came to the Chargers in 1978 and played for Air Coryell for 8 seasons. This great player will go into the Football Hall of Fame this October.
