Born in Springfield, Mass. in 1953, Mr. Dzwilewski attended Notre Dame and obtained his BA in English. He then attended Law School, graduated with honors and got his JD in 1979. He served as a Prosecuting Attorney with the Ingham County Prosecuting Attorneys' Office before he entered on duty with the FBI in 1980.

From 1980 to 1987 he was assigned to the Chicago Division where he gained field investigative experience in a wide variety of violations including RICO matters, kidnapping, and organized crime and many other complex white collar crime areas.

Mr. Dzwilewski served in Los Angeles and Washing, D.C. and Hawaii and encompassed everything from Legislative proposals to Terrorism and Counterintelligence crimes. In June, 2003, Mr. Dzwilewski was promoted to SAC of the San Diego Field Division.
