### WILLIAM M. LANSDOWNE

Chief Lansdowne was sworn in as San Diego's Chief of Police in August 2003. He took command of a department with 2,096 sworn officers, 766 civilian support personnel, and a budget of \$272 million. He reports directly to the City Manager. San Diego with a population of 1.27 million people is the seventh largest city in the United States.

Chief Lansdowne was born in Oakland, CA on may 10, 1944. He graduated from San Jose State University in 1973 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice Administration.

The Chief began his law enforcement career in 1966 when he joined the San Jose Police Department. Over the years he rose steadily through the ranks and in 1998 after a brief stint in Richmond, CA he became San Jose's "top cop".

Over the years, Chief Lansdowne has expanded his expertise and his reputation a one of the foremost law enforcement professionals in the country. He is a graduat of the FBI National Academy and has served on a variety of state and national boards, including the Major Cities Chiefs and the national Conference for Community and Justice.
