.....MAJOR DOUGLAS WILLIAMS

The Salvation Army's Adult Rehabilitation Center located at 12th & Broadway used to be located where the Horton Parkade now stands. The ARC has been in existence for over 100 years. Primarily the clients come through the Court systems and are usually between 20 and 30 years of age.

In June of 1998 Major Douglas Williams was appointed as the Administrator of the Adult Rehabilitation Center in San Diego. Doug graduated from The Salvation Army's College for Officers' Training & was commissioned as a Salvation Army Officer and minister in June 1974. His postings have been in New Mexico, Colorado, Montana and Utah and in these appointments he worked with youths, adult rehabilitation programs & emergency disaster services. Doug previously served as the General Secretary to the Adult Rehabilitation Centers Command for the Western Territory.

The clients in this program usually work FULL TIME at the Rehab Center which makes this program totally self-sustaining.
