PROFESSOR SAFIROV, PH.D. - PHILOSOPHY OF HISTORY, MOSCOW UNIVERSITY, 1977 WITH POST GRADUATE AND UNDERGRADUATE DEGREES FROM THE UNIVERSITY 1963-1970.

THE PROFESSOR HAS BEEN AT THE MOSCOW ACADEMY OF SCIENCES FROM 1970 TO THE PRESENT. HE HAS TRAVELED EXTENSIVELY LECTURING ON THE PROBLEMS IDENTIFIED IN HIS DISSERTATION -"POLITICAL REALISM AND POLITICAL IDEALISM IN THE HISTORY OF THE UNITED STATES FROM 1950 TO 1970 AS A PHILOSOPHICAL BASIS FOR U.S. FOREIGN POLICY."

PRIOR TO 1992 HIS TRAVELS WERE CONFINED TO THE U.S.S.R. AND HIS AUDIENCES INCLUDED UNIVERSITY PROFESSORS, WORKERS IN FACTORIES AND PLANTS, COLLECTIVE FARMERS, THE ATOMIC SUBMARINE "SOYUZ" CREW, GOLD MINERS IN SIBERIA AND THE SUPREME SOVIETS OF MANY AREAS. HE ALSO LECTURED ON CRUISELINERS TO VISITING AMERICANS.

SINCE 1992 PROF. SAFIROV HAS TRAVELED AND LECTURED EXTENSIVELY IN THE U.S. DR. SAFIROV'S EXCELLENT COMMAND OF THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND HIS CHARM AND SENSE OF HUMOR BRING TO LIFE THE FASCINATING HISTORY OF HIS IMPRESSIVE BUT MYSTERIOUS HOMELAND OF RUSSIA.

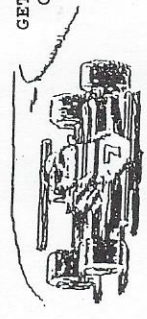
