BILL KOLENDER BECAME THE 28TH SHERIFF OF SAN DIEGO COUNTY ON JANUARY 2, 1995. PRIOR TO HIS ELECTION TO THE OFFICE OF SHERIFF, KOLENDER SERVED AS THE DIRECTOR OF THE CALIFORNIA YOUTH AUTHORITY, AN APPOINTMENT MADE BY GOV. PETE ON SEPT. 23, 1991. THE CALIFORNIA YOUTH AUTHORITY IS THE LARGEST YOUTH CORRECTIONAL AGENCY IN THE NATION.

KOLENDER HAS BEEN A CAREER LAW ENFORCEMENT PROFESSIONAL, SERVING FOR 13 YEARS AS THE CHIEF OF THE SAN DIEGO POLICE DEPARTMENT. HE WAS APPOINTED AT THE AGE OF 40-- ONE OF THE YOUNGEST BIG-CITY POLICE CHIEFS IN THE NATION--AND RETIRED IN 1988.

DESCRIBED BY THE GOVERNOR AS "FAIR BUT FIRM," KOLENDER STARTED WITH THE SAN DIEGO POLICE DEPARTMENT IN 1956 AND WORKED AT EVERY RANK ON HIS WAY TO BECOMING CHIEF IN 1975.

KOLENDER, A NATIVE OF CHICAGO, EARNED A BACHELOR OF ARTS DEGREE IN URBAN AFFAIRS AND PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION FROM SAN DIEGO STATE UNIV. IN 1964.

HE AND HIS WIFE, LOIS, HAVE FOUR CHILDREN.


I'VE GIVEN UP RUNNING FOR THE BUS. IT LEAVES FASTER THAN IT USED TO.
