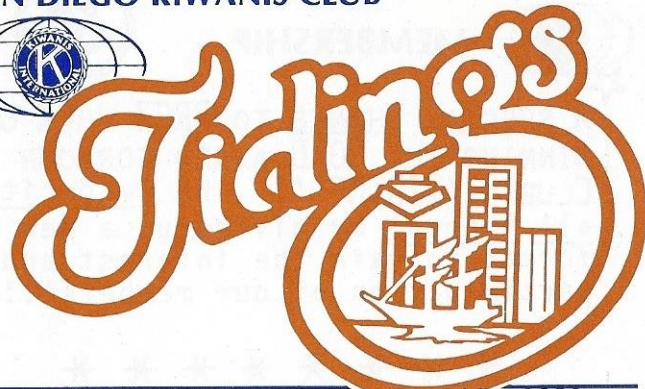

THE PROGRAM

On board a communist cruise ship a man; 51 years of age, clad only in swim trunks, panty hose and a red flannel shirt; slips quietly through a small porthole into the dark sea and begins his 20 hour, 48 kilometer swim through shark-infested waters, to at last fulfill his 25-year quest for freedom.

YURII VETOKHIN, a native Russian, believes in God. His parents died of starvation during the German seige of Leningrad in 1942. His wife reported him to the KGB (the Soviet secret police) for thinking anti-communist thoughts. Yurii was lucky, it was a time of liberal reform in Russia and he was not sent directly to prison. His wife received a divorce and Yurii was never allowed to see his eight-year-old son again. Yurii was left only with his belief in God and an unsatiated desire for freedom.

In 1963 he attempted to escape by swimming across the Black Sea to Turkey but was defeated by the strong currents. In 1967 he again attempted to escape by the Black Sea but was spotted by crew members in a patrol boat, returned to Russia, and turned over to the KGB. He was sentenced to prison, an experimental institution in Moscow where the Soviets send political prisoners and attempt to change their ideas with drugs. There the inmates are given injections and pills which induce horrible physical reactions and drive many of them mad. A truck would come every day to remove the dead bodies, leaving their bare legs exposed for the inmates to see. Yurii survived over 9 years in that 'prison', and is at last free!

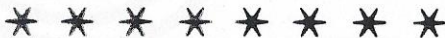
