DR. BARKEN IS CERTIFIED BY THE AMERICAN BOARD OF UROLOGY. AMONG OTHER DISTINCTIONS HE IS A FELLOW OF THE AMERICAN COLLEGE OF SURGEONS AND A FELLOW OF THE AMERICAN SOCIETY FOR LASER MEDICINE AND SURGERY. HE IS AN ASSISTANT CLINICAL PROFESSOR AT UCSD WHERE HE IS INVOLVED IN RESEARCH PROJECTS.

DR. BARKEN IS THE HOST AND PRODUCER OF COX CABLE'S "MEN AND MALE MEDICINE", A WEEKLY TELEVISION PROGRAM, HE HAS ALSO DONE NUMEROUS PATIENT EDUCATION VIDEOS AND LECTURES EXTENSIVELY FOR THE AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY.
