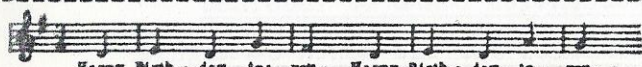

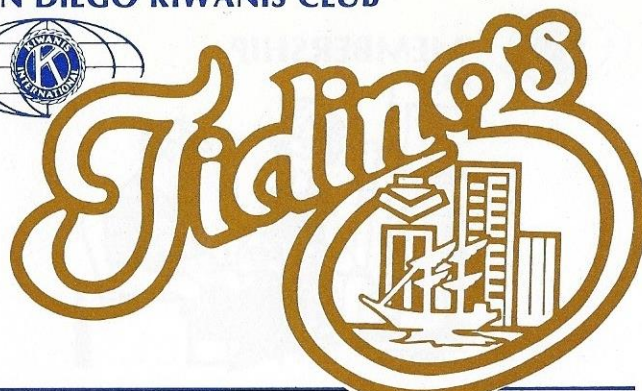

He has served extensively with Red Cross Chapter, Ecumenical Conference of San Diego, Chaplain of the Navy League, and originator of two counselling Centers. He has a background in Physchology & Philosophy with a Doctorate degree, and studied at Ocford University.
