

Dear Mark:

Enclosed is a copy of the new regulations that have come out on the Definition of a Club for the Purpose of Determining Disallowance of Deduction for Club Dues. In 1993 Congress passed a law which prohibited individuals from deducting dues paid to clubs which are organized for business, pleasure, recreation or other social purposes.

The new Treasury Regulations recognize that civic or public service organizations, such as the Kiwanis Club, will be excepted from the provisions causing disallowance, since they are not organized for a principal purpose of conducting entertainment activities for members or providing access to entertainment facilities for the members.
