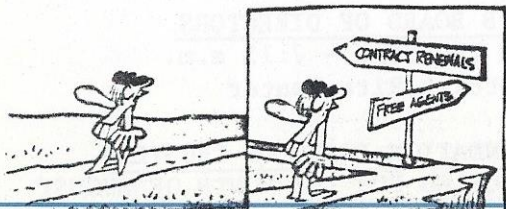

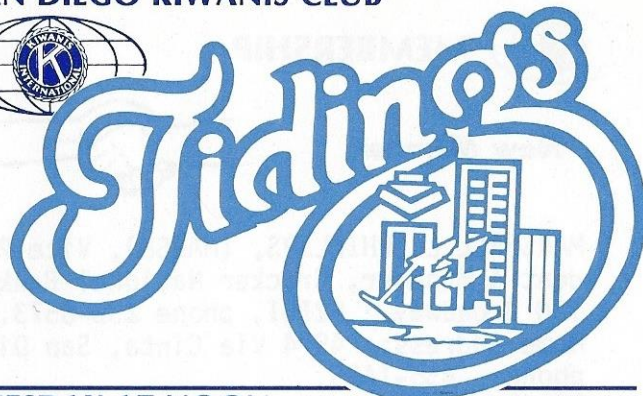

OUR CLUB is now the sponsor of Leadership Post 2099 with a current membership of over 20 members.

GUS WHITCOMB, Chairman of the EPA and President of Post 2099, is eagerly looking forward to the first meeting for the new Post set for September 3rd. The Associate Student Body Presidents of all San Diego area High Schools will be contacted in late September to increase membership, and other young people who have expressed an interest in this area will also be contacted.
