THE PROGRAM

.....MANAGER BRUCE BOCHY

BRUCE DOUGLAS BOCHY WAS BORN IN LANDES DE BOUSSAC, FRANCE ON APRIL 16, 1955. BRUCE AND HIS WIFE KIM HAVE TWO SONS, GREG 15 AND BRETT 8 AND MAKE THEIR HOME IN SAN DIEGO. BRUCE ATTENDED BREVARD COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN COCOA BEACH, FL AND FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY IN TALLAHASSEE.. DURING THAT TIME, HIS BROTHER, JOE WAS A CATCHER IN THE MINNESOTA ORGANIZATION FROM 1969 TO 1972. BRUCE'S PRO CAREER BEGAN WITH THE HOUSTON ORGANIZATION IN 1975 AND MADE HIS MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT WITH THE ASTROS IN 1978. BRUCE CAME TO THE PADRES IN FEBRUARY, 1983, SIGNING A MINOR LEAGUE CONTRACT BEFORE HIS CONTRACT WAS PURCHASED BY THE MAJOR LEAGUE CLUB JUNE 29 OF THAT YEAR. BESIDES SPENDING TIME WITH HOUSTON AND THE PADRES BRUCE ALSO SAW ACTION WITH THE NEW YORK METS IN 1982.


BRUCE BECAME THE 15TH MANAGER IN PADRES' HISTORY ON OCT 21, 1994. HE IS THE YOUNGEST SKIPPER IN THE NATIONAL LEAGUE WITH ONLY BUCK SHOWALTER OF THE NEW YORK YANKEES YOUNGER IN THE AMERICAN LEAGUE. THIS YEAR IS BRUCE'S FIRST AS MANAGER IN THE BIG LEAGUES. BRUCE SPENT FOUR SEASONS MANAGING IN SAN DIEGO'S FARM SYSTEM BEFORE SPENDING THE 1993 AND 1994 SEASONS AS THE PADRES'S THIRD BASE COACH. HE IS THE ONLY MANAGER TO ALSO WEAR THE PADRES UNIFORM DURING HIS PLAYING DAYS.
