HIS DUTIES WERE TO ENLIST YACHT CLUBS THROUGHOUT THE NATION IN SUPPORT OF THE SAN DIEGO YACHT CLUB EFFORT TO BRING BACK THE CUP FROM AUSTRALIA. IN 1992 HE PLAYED A SIGNIFICANT ROLE IN THE RACES AND AGAIN IN 1995 HE WILL BE ON THE WATER FOR THE RACE.
