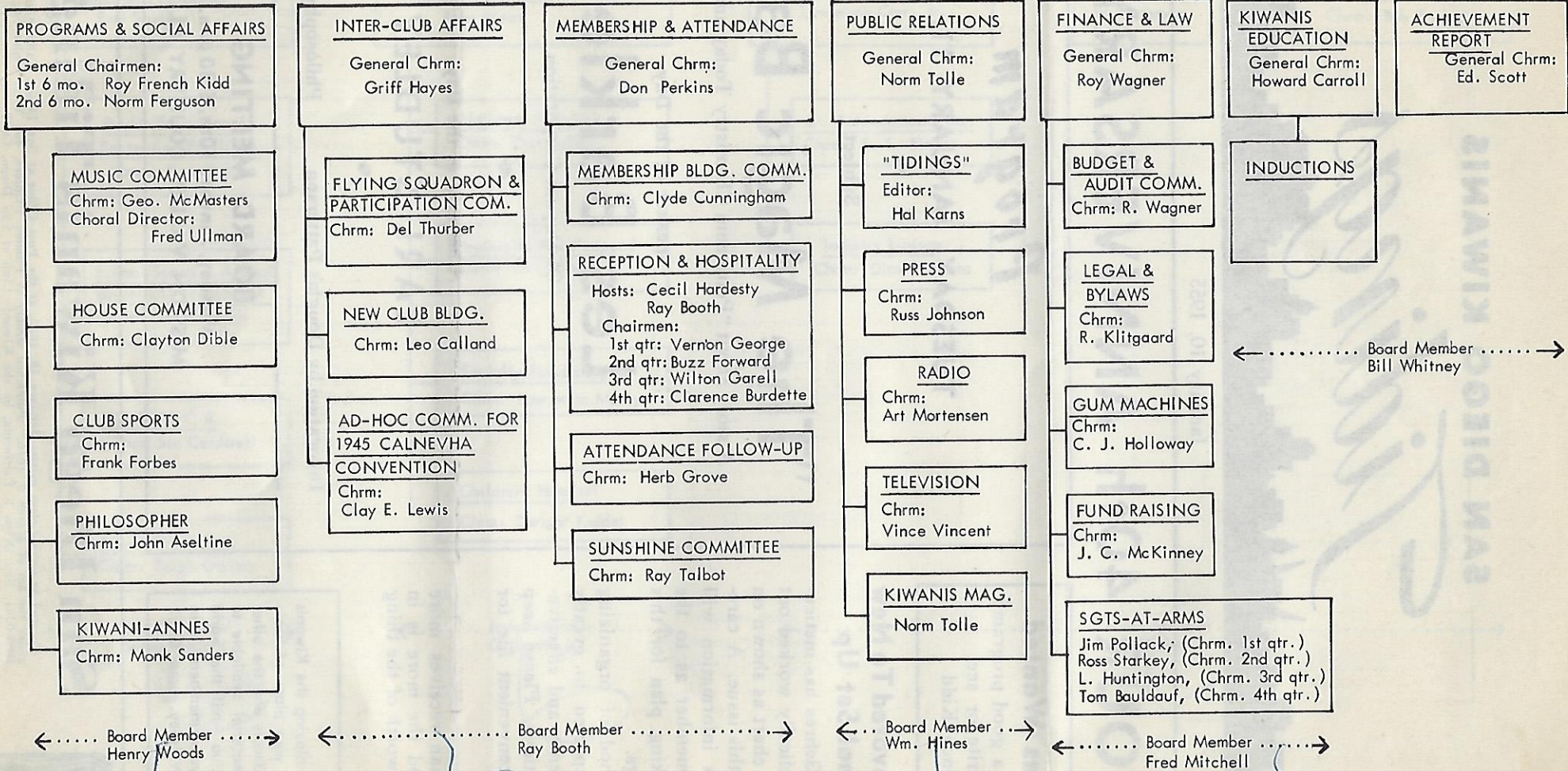


San Diego Kiwanis Club - Committee Structure for 1955

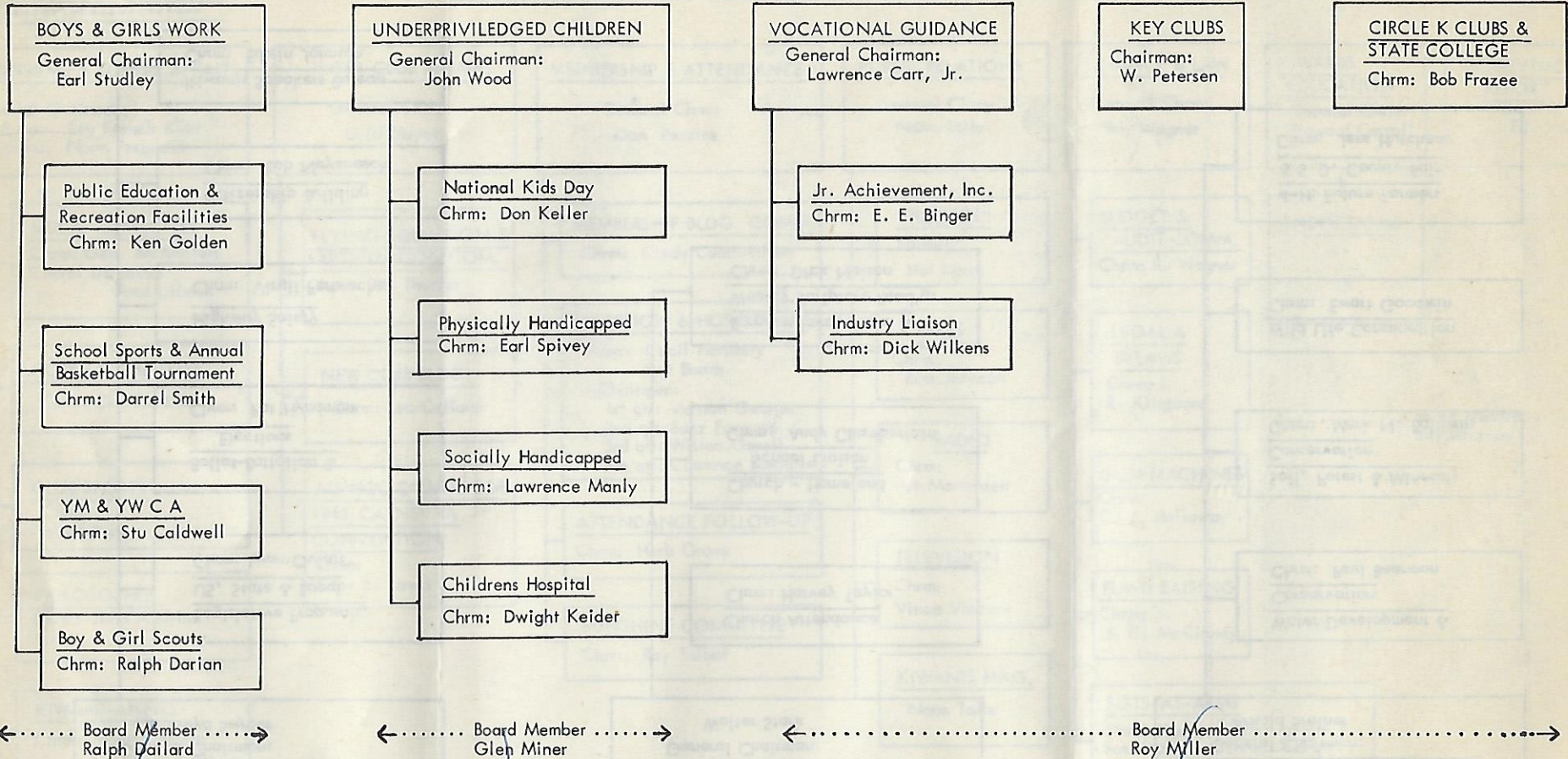
