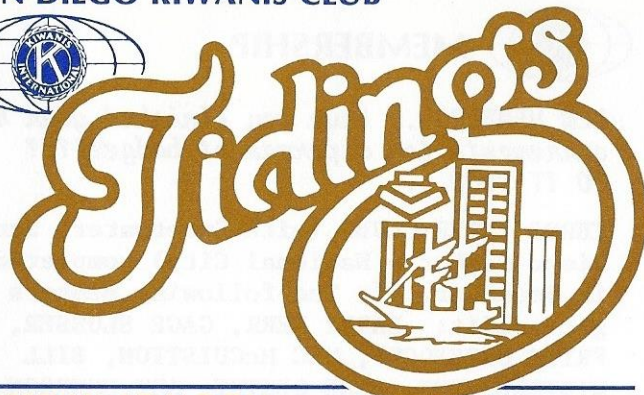

THE PROGRAM

Dr. Robert Panzer served as minister for the First Methodist Church, Sacramento for 22 years before coming to Coronado where he has been with the Church of the Voyager for the past seven years. He has also been District Superintendent over two different districts.

In the late 1950's, Dr. Panzer started 'travel groups' as his hobby, arranging interviews with foreign leaders and visiting mission projects. Since 1950, he has traveled around the world ten times and to numerous countries on shorter trips.

In April, 1980, he took 21 people into China where they visited Canton, Nanning, Kweiling, Changsha, and Peking -- returning by way of Hong Kong and Korea. He interviewed a top national leader in tourism, people in religion, education, medicine and trade. He will revisit China in April of this year.

Upon retirement, Dr. Panzer expects to travel full-time and continue 'resourcing' churches to grow.
