BILL TOONE IS THE CURATOR OF OR-NITHOLOGY FOR THE ZOOLOGICAL SOC-IETY OF SAN DIEGO AT THE SAN DIEGO WILD ANIMAL PARK AND HAS BEEN AT THE ZOO SINCE OCTOBER 1980. BIOLOGY STUDIES, BACHELOR OF SCIENCE, AND MASTER OF SCIENCE. DEPT OF AVIAN SCIENCES WERE ALL OBTAINED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA AT DAVIS.

BILL HAS BEEN ACTIVE IN CONSER-VATION EFFORTS ON A LOCAL, NA-TIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL LEVEL. WELL KNOWN FOR HIS STANDS ON ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES, HE HAS TAKEN STRONG POSITIONS ON ISSUES SUCH AS THE RECOVERY OF THE CALI-FORNIA CONDOR, THE LEAST BELL'S VIREO, BLACK-TAILED GNATCATCHER, THE COASTAL CACTUS WREN, PARROTS, GLOBAL CONSERVATION OF PIGEONS AND OTHERS.
