BILL TOONE IS THE CURATOR OF ORNITHOLOGY FOR THE ZOOLOGICAL SOCIETY OF SAN DIEGO AT THE SAN DIEGO WILD ANIMAL PARK AND HAS BEEN AT THE ZOO SINCE OCTOBER 1980. HIS BIOLOGY STUDIES, BACHELOR OF SCIENCE, AND MASTER OF SCIENCE, DEPT OF AVIAN SCIENCES WERE ALL OBTAINED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA AT DAVIS.

BILL HAS BEEN ACTIVE IN CONSERVATION EFFORTS ON A LOCAL, NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL LEVEL. 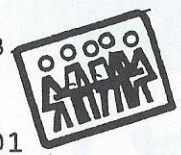
