RICK BAY, A MAN WHO HAD DIRECTED INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS PROGRAMS IN THE PACIFIC 10 AND BIG 10 CONFERENCES AND WHO SERVED AS CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER FOR TWO MAJOR LEAGUE BASEBALL CLUBS, IS THE 12TH DIRECTOR OF ATHLETICS AT SAN DIEGO STATE UNIVERSITY.

BAY, 52, WHO HAD BEEN IN PRIVATE BUSINESS FOR THE TWO YEARS PRIOR TO BEING SELECTED BY SDSU AS PRESIDENT OF RICK BAY, INC. OFFICIALLY ASSUMED HIS AZTEC DUTIES ON FEBRUARY 15, 1995. HE TOOK OVER FROM FRED MILLER, WHO RETIRED AFTER NINE YEARS AS SDSU DIRECTOR OF ATHLETICS.

RICHARD BAY'S FIRST JOB AS AN ATHLETIC DIRECTOR WAS AT THE UNIV. OF OREGON 1981-84 THEN HE WAS ON TO OHIO STATE FROM 1984-88. BAY RESIGNED HIS POST AT OSU AS A RESULT OF THE FIRING OF FOOTBALL COACH EARLE BRUCE.

AFTER A BRIEF STINT AS EXEC V.P. AND CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER FOR THE NEW YORK YANKEES, BAY ASSUMED THE ATHLETIC DIRECTORSHIP AT THE UNIV. OF MINNESOTA 1988-91. BAY WENT FROM THERE TO THE CLEVELAND INDIANS AND LEFT THEM IN THE FALL OF 1992.

RICK WAS BORN AND GREW UP IN WAIKEGAN, ILL. AND ATTENDED THE UNIV OF MICHIGAN ON A WRESTLING SCHOLARSHIP AND PLAYED VARSITY FOOTBALL AS WELL. HE GRADUATED WITH A LIBERAL ARTS DEGREE IN 1965.
