THE PROGRAM

.....IAN D. CAMPBELL

THE GENERAL DIRECTOR OF SAN DIEGO OPERA IS AUSTRALIAN-BORN IAN D. CAMPBELL.

CAMPBELL, 48, IS A GRADUATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SYDNEY AND AN ASSOCIATE FELLOW OF THE AUSTRALIAN INSTITUTE OF MANAGEMENT.

HE BEGAN HIS OPERATIC CAREER IN 1967 AS A PRINCIPAL TENOR WITH THE AUSTRALIAN OPERA AND SANG FOR SEVEN SEASONS. HE MOVED INTO MANAGEMENT IN 1974 AS SENIOR MUSIC OFFICER FOR THE AUSTRALIAN COUNCIL, THE NATIONAL FUNDING AUTHORITY FOR THE ARTS.

IN 1976, HE WAS APPOINTED GENERAL MANAGER OF THE STATE OPERA OF SOUTH AUSTRALIA AND IN 1982 MOVED TO NEW YORK AND WORKED AT THE METROPOLITAN OPERA. IN JULY 1983, HE CAME TO SAN DIEGO AS GENERAL DIRECTOR AND HIS CURRENT CONTRACT RUNS THROUGH JUNE, 1998.

CAMPBELL PRODUCES AND HOSTS TWO RADIO PROGRAMS ON KFSD-FM - 'THE SAN DIEGO OPERA RADIO PROGRAM' ON SUNDAY EVENINGS THROUGHOUT THE OPERA SEASON AND 'AT THE OPERA WITH IAN CAMPBELL' ON SATURDAY MORNINGS DURING THE SUMMER.
