CHIEF JERRY SANDERS WAS BORN IN SAN PEDRO, CALIFORNIA ON JULY 14, 1950. HE AND HIS WIFE RANA HAVE TWO DAUGHTERS.

HE JOINED THE SAN DIEGO POLICE DEPARTMENT IN APRIL, 1973 AS A POLICE OFFICER. SERVED IN ALL RANKS PRIOR TO APPOINTMENT TO CHIEF OF POLICE ON MAY 17, 1993.

IN JUNE 1993 THE CHIEF ESTABLISHED THE NEIGHBORHOOD POLICING RESTRUCTURING PROJECT FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEVELOPING A PLAN TO REALIGN AND INTERGRATE THE "BEAT" SYSTEM INTO THE COMMUNITIES. IN SEPTEMBER 1994, HE INTRODUCED THE COMMUNITY COMPUTER BULLETIN BOARD ENABLING CITIZENS TO ACCESS CITY AND NEIGHBORHOOD CRIME STATS, THE WATCH COMMANDER'S LOG AND SAN DIEGO'S "10 MOST WANTED" CRIMINALS LIST.

AS THE CHIEF OF POLICE HE IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS AND POLICIES, WITH AN ANNUAL BUDGET OF \$180 MILLION. HE SUPERVISES 1,950 SWORN OFFICERS PLUS 1,000 NONSWORN AND RESERVES. CHIEF SANDERS REPORTS DIRECTLY TO THE CITY MANAGER.
