SUSAN HOFFMAN BEGAN HER RADIO CAREER IN LEXINGTON, KENTUCKY IN 1978 AS AN ACCOUNT EXECUTIVE FOR AOR WKQQ-FM. SHE WAS PROMOTED TO REGIONAL SALES MANAGER. SHE EVEN SPENT SOME TIME BEHIND THE MIC BEFORE GARY EDENS ENTICED HER TO HOUSTON, TEXAS FOR AN ACCT EXEC POSITION WITH KYND-FM IN 1980, WHICH LATER BECAME GANNETT'S KKBQ-FM. HOFFMAN SPENT TIME AT ANOTHER HOUSTON STATION 1982-83 BUT THEN IN 1984 SHE RETURNED TO GANNETT AND WAS PROMOTED TO LOCAL SALES MANAGER.

HOFFMAN LEFT GANNETT IN 1986 AND BECAME EMMIS' LOCAL SALES MANAGER, AND THEN GENERAL SALES MANAGER, FOR KPWR-FM, LOS ANGELES' TOP-RANKED STATION.

IN 1988 SHE RETURNED TO HOUSTON AS VICE PRES/GENL MGR OF KNRJ-FM/KKHT-FM. SHE ALSO WORKED AS A CONSULTANT TO MAXIMUM RADIO IN PARIS, FRANCE FOR EMMIS BROADCASTING.

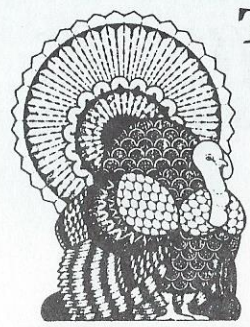

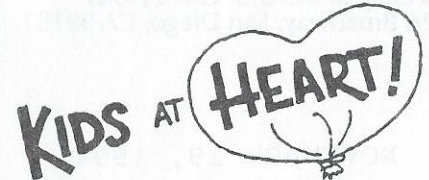
HAVE YOU EVER BEEN TAKEN IN BY A
