.....FRED TRENKLE

FRED TRENKLE WAS NAMED SAN DIEGO STATE'S 13TH MEN'S HEAD BASKETBALL COACH ON MAY 16, 1994.

THE 46-YEAR-OLD TRENKLE WON OVER 90% OF HIS GAMES IN 10 SEASONS AS HEAD COACH AT THE COLLEGE OF SOUTHERN IDAHO FROM 1983 TO 1993, COMPILING A RECORD OF 329-34. HIS TEAM WON THE NATIONAL JUNIOR COLLEGE TITLE IN 1987 AND HE WAS NAMED THE NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR IN 1987 AND 1992. HE WAS ALSO NAMED THE REGION 18 COACH OF THE YEAR EIGHT CONSECUTIVE SEASONS AND HIS SQUAD SET A NATIONAL RECORD WITH 137 CONSECUTIVE HOME COURT VICTORIES.

FRED IS ALSO COMMITTED TO ACADEMICS AS EVIDENCED BY HIS RECORD OF HAVING GRADUATED 70 OF THE 71 ATHLETES (AT SOUTHERN IDAHO) NEEDING AN AA DEGREE TO MOVE ON TO A FOUR-YEAR SCHOOL. IT IS BELIEVED THAT THIS IS THE GUY WHO CAN TAKE THE AZTEC PROGRAM TO THE NEXT LEVEL.

TRENKLE GRADUATED FROM IDAHO STATE IN 1970 AND EARNED HIS MASTERS DEGREE FROM THE COLLEGE OF IDAHO IN 1975. HE IS MARRIED WITH 3 SONS AND A DAUGHTER. FRED HAS BEEN ON SABBATICAL THIS PAST YEAR, FOLLOWING HIS THREE SONS' HIGH SCHOOL AND COLLEGIATE BASKETBALL CAREERS. AUTHOR AND PHOTOGRAPHER, PAYNE JOHNSON WILL TAKE US ON A UNIQUE ADVENTURE THROUGH MAYAN RUINS.
