THE PROGRAM

.....LARRY STIRLING

LARRY GRADUATED FROM SAN DIEGO STATE IN 1964. WENT ON TO SERVE IN KOREA AND THEN AFTER ACTIVE DUTY WENT TO WORK FOR THE CITY MANAGER'S STAFF. HIS INVOLVEMENT WITH THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM BEGAN IN THE EARLY 1970'S WHEN, AS AN ANALYST FOR THE SAN DIEGO POLICE DEPARTMENT, HE WORKED ON A SPECIAL TASK FORCE UNDER CHIEF OF POLICE, RAY HOOBLER, WHICH COMPUTERIZED AND MODERNIZED THE DEPARTMENT.

LATER, AS A SAN DIEGO CITY COUNCIL MEMBER, LARRY WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN BRINGING ABOUT 911-DIALING AND THE DECENTRALIZATION OF THE POLICE DEPT. FOR QUICKER RESPONSE TIMES.

FOR NINE YEARS, LARRY WAS A MEMBER OF THE CALIFORNIA LEGISLATURE, FIRST SERVING IN THE ASSEMBLY AND THEN IN THE STATE SENATE. LARRY SERVED ON THE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE AND FOR THREE YEARS CHAIRED THE ASSEMBLY COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC SAFETY. DURING HIS TENURE, LARRY AUTHORIZED NUMEROUS BILLS STRENGTHENING LAW ENFORCEMENT, JUDICIARY AND CORRECTIONS.

LARRY WAS APPOINTED TO THE SAN DIEGO BENCH BY GOVERNOR GEORGE DEUKMEJIAN IN 1989.
