SHE SITS ON THE HOUSE ENERGY AND COMMERCE COMMITTEE, SERVING ON THE TELE-COMMUNICATIONS AND FINANCE AND TRANSPORTATION AND HAZARDOUS MA-TERIALS SUBCOMMITTEES. COASTAL LOCATION AS WELL AS REP. SCHENK'S EXPERIENCE IN ENVIRON-MENTAL ISSUES, HELPED HER GAIN A SEAT ON THE HOUSE MERCHANT MARINE AND FISHERIES COMMITTEE.

## ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING CLUB DUES

1993, CONGRESS REVISED THE INTER-NAL REVENUE CODE TO PROHIBIT ANY DEDUCTION FOR MEMBERSHIP IN ANY CLUB ORGANIZED FOR BUSINESS, PLEASURE, RECREATION OR OTHER SOCIAL PURPOSE.

I AM PLEASED TO INFORM OUR MEM-BERS THAT THE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE HAS HAS ISSUED A NEW PROPOSED REGULATION SECTION 1.274-2, EXPLAINING THAT CIVIC OR PUBLIC SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS SUCH AS KIWANIS ARE NOT SUBJECT TO THIS DISALLOWANCE RULE, SINCE IT IS NOT OUR PRINCIPAL PURPOSE TO CONDUCT ENTERTAINMENT ACTI-VITIES FOR OUR MEMBERS OR GUESTS. AS A CONSEQUENCE OF THIS PROPOSED REGULATION, YOU MAY CONTINUE TO DEDUCT YOUR KIWANIS EXPENSES FOR TAX PURPOSES IN THE SAME MANNER AS YOU TREATED THEM PRIOR TO THE 1993 AMENDMENT.
