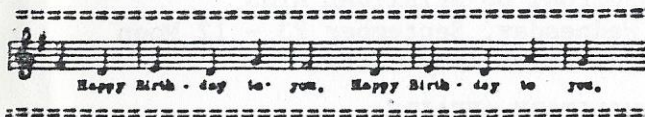

THE PROGRAM

MARK "EVANS" AUSTAD, the American Ambassador Designate to Norway. Mark was informed of his appointment to Norway on the most important day of Ronald Reagan's Presidency to date - the day his budget was passed!

Mark brings to his post over 30 years on the Washington scene as a broadcaster, lecturer, commentator and former executive of Metromedia. He hosted the "Opinion in the Capitol" program, was a commentator on the CBS Radio Station WTOP in Washington (replacing Arthur Godfrey), and did commercials for "I Love Lucy" and "Our Miss Brooks" shows.

From 1975 to 1977 he served as Ambassador to Finland. In 1973, Mark was a delegate to the 28th General Assembly of the United Nations, and in 1975 was a U. S. Delegate to the conference on European Security in Helsinki, Finland serving with President Ford and Secretary Kissinger.

He became the first Ambassador to Finland to receive the White Rose and the Order of the Lion from the government of Finland. Mark also received the Statesman of the Year award from the prestigious Washington State Evergreen Council.

During his years in Washington, Ambassador Austad served as a Director of the City's Board of Trade; Chairman of the Bicentennial Commission, Cherry Blossom Festival; Chairman of the Eisenhower Convention Center Committee; a Member of the Convention & Visitors' Bureau; Chairman of the 1968 Inaugural Ball and Vice Chairman of the entire Inaugural in 1972.

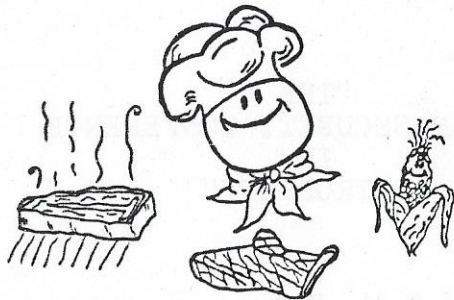
